TUITION

As a reminder, tuition is due the first week of each month, unless you have made other arrangements with us.

Don't forget that we offer a 5% discount for bi-annual tuition payments. If you would like to take advantage of this discount & pay the remainder of this year's tuition no later than February 12th, please see Miss Kim.

COSTUME PAYMENTS

Costume payments resume this month for those making multiple payments. Your daughter's costumes will **NOT** be ordered if at least half of the total amount for costumes has not been paid by this month and/or if you are behind on tuition payments.



PRACTICE MUSIC

We are starting to learn our dances for the recital in June. It is important for students to practice their routines at home, at least a few times a week.

If you have an MP3 player, memory card or memory/jump drive, I can give you a file each week of the vocal instructions for the steps we learn that week. There will be a new combination every week or two so **please make sure you get an updated copy of the vocal instructions each week.**

For those who do not have a digital means to receive the vocal instructions, I can provide one CD of the practice music per family, **at your request.** Duplicates of this CD may be purchased for \$1 each. The CD's do not have the vocal instructions on them - only the music.

I do keep track of those students on a "star chart" and find that those students who have their vocal instructions updated regularly **and** practice at home show improvement in class.

PARENT OBSERVATION

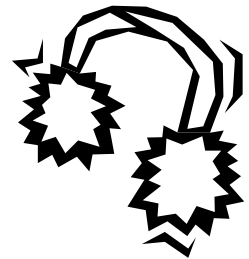
As stated in the handbook, November was the last month for parent observation. There will be one additional parent observation during the first week of April.

CLASS ATTENDANCE

As we begin our recital routines, one of the problems we have is attendance. It seems as though weeks will go by before we have a 'whole' class sometimes! Your child's class needs to begin dancing as a group, with everyone there every week. This is especially important if we are utilizing partners or other special effects in her dance. Continual absences are very stressful on both the teacher and the students. Please make every effort to have your child at the class every week.



INCLEMENT WEATHER

When Farmington R-7 Schools are closed because of snow or other inclement weather, we will usually not have dance classes. **Please call me if in doubt.**


